

TOWN OF POMONA PARK COMMUNITY YARD SALE VENDOR RULES

Saturday, November 7, 2026

Event Hours and Locations: The sale will be held from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Cow Catcher, 1712 South U.S. Highway 17, and Mayor's Park, 107 Worcester Avenue.

Registration: Applications and full payment are due by Thursday, November 5, 2026, at 4:00 p.m. The fee is \$10 per 12-foot by 12-foot space. Applications are available at Town Hall or by emailing finance@pomonapark-fl.gov or townclerk@pomonapark-fl.gov.

Setup: Friday setup may begin at 12:00 p.m. on November 6. Gates will reopen at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday. The Town does not provide overnight security; vendors are responsible for securing their property.

Vehicles and Parking: All vehicles must be outside the sale area by 7:45 a.m. Vendors must park in designated areas. Vehicles are not permitted in the sale area from 8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. and may not reenter until Town staff determines it is safe.

Cleanup: All unsold items, trash, and other materials must be removed by 3:00 p.m. on Saturday. Failure to leave the assigned area clean may result in exclusion from future Town events.

Items Permitted: Personal items such as clothing, toys, books, household goods, small furniture and appliances, plants, woodworking items, and handmade crafts may be sold.

Items Prohibited: Hazardous materials, firearms, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, animals, and any item that is illegal to possess or sell are prohibited.

Conduct and Safety: Vendors and visitors must behave respectfully and courteously. Children must be supervised at all times. Loud music, disruptive behavior, and unsafe activity are not permitted.

Security and Liability: Vendors are responsible for their own property and belongings. The Town of Pomona Park is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Weather and Refunds: The event will be held rain or shine. Registration fees are nonrefundable.

Compliance: Vendors must follow these rules and all directions from Town staff. Noncompliance may result in removal from the event and exclusion from future yard sales.
